Greek America Corps

This is an initiative that has changed the lives of dozens of North American young adults by engaging them in meaningful volunteer programs in Greece — and immersing them in contemporary Greek life and culture. Our programs connect volunteers with their inner-selves and instill in them the importance of volunteerism, service and philanthropy by allowing them to experience firsthand the smile on the face of someone they are feeding, supporting or serving. This initiative also supports Greece and her people as they grapple with crippling financial crisis and numerous humanitarian issues. When made possible through the generosity of donors, we provide scholarships for students to participate in these programs, where they work with our reputable non-profit partners in Greece.

Academic Programs

These programs derive from our firm belief in the value education. Our Semester in Athens scholarships have provided life-changing experiences for dozens of North American students to study at US-accredited universities in Greece. These experiences immerse them in contemporary Greek society and culture — allowing them to become more well-rounded citizens of the world. Additionally, our Constantine and Patricia Mavroyannis Scholarship has awarded a total of \$90,000 to 18 Greek PhD students in theoretical physics or physical chemistry. This scholarship thus rewards and encourages educational achievement while supporting Greeks' contributions to the global scientific community. Both of the aforementioned scholarships are crucial in maintaining and developing connections between Greece and North America.

Project Hope for Greece

This project inspires philanthropy among Greek North Americans and encourages our supporters on a grassroots level to raise funds and awareness for various accredited charitable organizations doing important work in Greece. These organizations work in sectors ranging from poverty and homelessness to child welfare, among others. Over the years, our friends and supporters have organized and hosted events in their homes, businesses and other venues — some raising tens of thousands of dollars in a single night.
